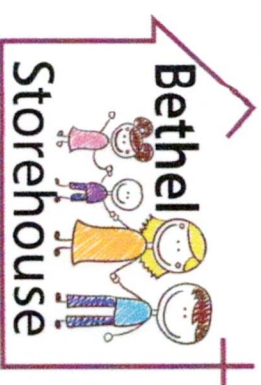

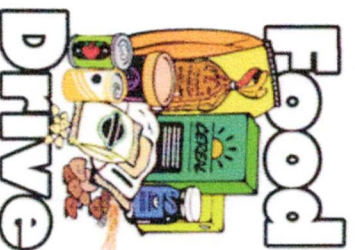

Client Services February 2024

- Total value of services given = \$14,168.82**
- Total # of people helped –1832 people = 700 families
- Senior clients – 412 people
- Disabled clients – 106 people
- Children – 515 people
- Homeless –25 people
- Travelers – 2 people
- Transients – 1 person
- Total # of people for food – 1701 = 658 families
- Purchased food –\$1791.47 on 10,284 pounds
- Donated food – 38,223 pounds = \$9555.75
- Total food –48,507 pounds = \$11,347.22
- Clothes – 332 people = 113 families = \$1584.45
- Coats – 172 people = \$320.90
- Housewares/furniture – 50 families, 140 people = \$580.70
- Misc. items – 4 families, 11 people = \$36.55
- Pantry Misc. – 99 people = \$219.00
- Gas Vouchers – 4 people = \$80.00
- New Clients – 411 people

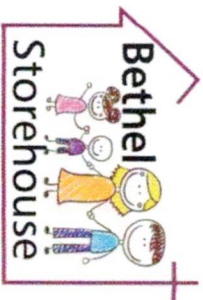
