Total # of people helped – 1649 people = 632 families

Senior clients – 409 people

Disabled clients – 93 people

Children – 454 people

Homeless – 13 people

Total # of people for food – 1521 = 602 families

Purchased food – \$4262.75 on 21,322 pounds

Donated food – 31,032 pounds = \$9757.40

Total food – 52,354 pounds = \$14,020.15

Clothes – 332 people = 96 families = \$1252.91

Housewares/furniture – 39 families, 111 people = \$370.45

Misc. items – 9 families, 24 people = \$56.55

Pantry Misc. – 809 people = \$4388.00

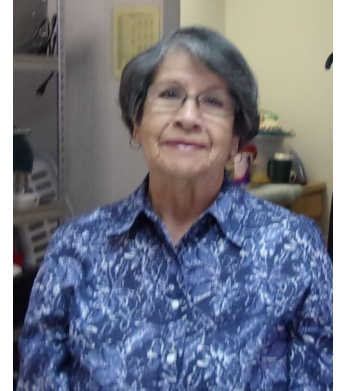
Have issued a new Challenge Grant for Bethel Community Storehouse For the amount of \$20,000
