am writing to you today about our holiday giving appeal. It is the most important fundraising campaign we conduct all year. For 37 years, the Bethel Community Storehouse (an interfaith community mission) has provided a variety of services to our neighbors in need all across the greater Estancia Valley/East Mountain area. In 2023, we helped 19,705 people (7269 families).5898 of these clients were children under the age of 18 and 4410 were seniors over the age of 60. We are humbly asking for your help. 2024 has been a difficult year for so many people. As we head into the holiday season, our neighbors are facing more uncertainty and need on so many levels. The winter months are hard on families with the extra expense of the holiday, heating costs, the end of seasonal work and now extreme inflation. When winter sets in, some of our clients must choose between paying their utility bills or buying food or medicine. Bethel is expecting to help 4500 people over the next 2 months for the holiday season. We not only provide groceries, but also toys and Christmas stockings for the children. We will continue to help with warm clothing, coats, furniture and household items as
