Total value of services given = \$23,539.50  
Total # of people helped –1744 people  
=650 families  
Senior clients – 422 people  
Disabled clients – 95 people  
Children – 461 people  
Homeless –13 people  
Travelers – 1 person  
Transients – 1 person  
Total # of people for food – 1593  
=613 families  
Includes holiday foods  
Purchased food –\$7125.17 on 7745 pounds  
Donated food – 54,252 pounds = \$13,563.00  
Total food –61,997pounds = \$20,688.17  
Clothes – 314 people = 786 families = \$1180.58  
Housewares/furniture – 30 families, 71 people = \$404.75  
Misc. items – 2 families, 2 people = \$30.00  
Easter Baskets – 90 children = \$450.00  
Pantry Misc. – 94 people = \$786.00  
New Clients – 189 people
