Did you know?

The poverty rate in Tarrant County is currently about 18.3%. The national average is 10.6%. That means nearly 1 in 5 residents are living below the federal poverty line, compared to 1 in 10 nationally. This places Tarrant County significantly above the national average and reflects many of the economic challenges faced in rural parts of New Mexico, which itself has one of the highest poverty rates among U.S. states.

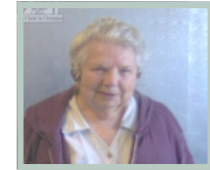
